

GCSE Coursework: 60% Final GCSE Grade

All Artist research must have the following:

- Title of Artist
- 3 images of artist's work. **AO1**
- Describe in detail with artist terms what you can see in one of their art pieces. **AO1/AO3**
- Accurate copies of the artist's work. Use the same techniques and materials **AO2**
(if you do not have these materials ask me)
- Summary box with a sentence What are you inspired by? **AO3**
(Some of you have looked at designers and art movements that requires the same as Art research)

Observation A4 minimum size: AO2 & AO3

- X1 minimum: Realism Tonal Graphite Observation of an image showing your coursework theme choice.
- X1 minimum: Observation in a medium and technique of your choice. E.g biro, paint, charcoal
(Top tip, use a medium you have used or will use in your final piece)
- X1 Minimum: Quality Observation inspire by your artists and your coursework title.
(This can be colour, theme or technique)

Sketchbook: Initial ideas and intentions. AO3

- 3 different ideas: Sketches or image collage
- Annotation: Materials, techniques, research inspiration, meaning or intentions for the piece.

Development and Exploration: AO2

Produce a minimum of 4 A5 or bigger, versions of your favorite ideas using materials and techniques all ready tried in your sketchbook or by your artists.

Don't forget to stick in any:

- Material/technique samples (these might have been on scrap papers e.g trialing mixing paint shades)
- Annotation: reference ideas, meaning, research, personal opinions of outcome

You could be using any of the below if your artist uses it or it is similar.

- Painting: canvas, paper, cardboard, acrylic, watercolour, oils ect
- Drawing: graphite, pen, chalk, ink, sewing, machine
- Sculpture: wire, Modroc, clay, plasticine, cardboard, wood.
- Photography: digital or manual
- Digital media
- Print
- Textiles

Final Response planning. AO3

- Final Idea Sketch
- Annotation any changes from above.
