### Literacy

This half term we will be writing our own adventure stories in the Amazon, based on the introduction of 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell.

We will also be exploring and creating our own structured poetry related to the rainforests.

# Art/DT

We will study, create and evaluate art by Henri Rousseau.

# Geography

We will be locating rainforests around the world; exploring life there (humans and animals); and looking at the issues rainforests are facing.

We will be continuing swimming lessons on Wednesday afternoons, as well as Athletics on a Thursday.

# Numeracy

We will continue to follow the Maths No Problem scheme in year 5. This allows children to develop their own understanding of a new concept and apply it. The first two maths areas we will cover are place value to 1,000,000 and addition and subtraction.
