can write at varying length, for different purposes and audiences, using the variety of of a range of writing in the language studied.

speak with increasing confidence, fluency and spontaneity, finding ways of communicating

Our Intent

At Mereside Primary Academy the MFL Curriculum enables our pupils to learn together and achieve together to understand and respond to Spanish in both verbal and written form. Through authentic sources and enthusiastic teaching we empower our students to learn, understand and respond as authentic Spanish linguists using initiative and spontaneity. We equip students with the vocabulary and grammar structures that enable them to build upon their knowledge of languages whilst at and after they leave Mereside. We aim to develop children's respect for others both in our communities and around the world and we want to build up their cultural capital and widen horizons through high quality visitors and themed events, such as European Day of Languages.
