Elmer's big parade:

We are delighted to announce that we are going to be involved in Elmer's Big Parade!

Elmer's Big Parade Blackpool is a free, family-friendly public art trail featuring a herd of 30 large decorated elephant sculptures and 30 young Elmers, positioned in open spaces and at key landmarks around Blackpool. There will be an app that the children can use to find the elephants that are placed around Blackpool. The elephants are sponsored by different schools and organisations to raise money for Brain house (a local charity). Our children are in the process of designing and decorating our elephant and we can't wait to show off our work in the parade!

After school activities:

Our after-school activities will be starting again next week. You should have received a form on parent app today to be able to sign your child up for the different clubs. Recent national research has highlighted the positive impact of attending after school activities, especially for social reasons and to develop a child's self esteem so please try and sign your child up for at least one club.
