- a) Variety of Content: Digital libraries provide access to thousands of books, articles, videos, and interactive media that cater to various reading levels and interests.
- **b)** Instant Access: Children can access these resources anytime and anywhere, whether on a computer, tablet, or smartphone, helping to foster a love for reading and learning.
- **c) Engaging Multimedia:** Digital libraries often include multimedia elements such as videos, animations, and interactive quizzes that enhance learning and make it more engaging for children.

Finally, next week, your child's class teacher will be sending home information on how to access some exciting reading resources online.







#### Year 6
