
CURRICULUM SPOTLIGHT

From the moment he arrived children were buzzing with excitement. He started by leading an assembly and the children were captivated from the moment they met him. They laughed, listened and were fascinated with his storytelling. Phil then took the time to meet each child and signed a copy of his new book for them to take home. Children will remember this day for a long time. We will be working to ensure we have other famous authors coming to visit our school to share their lives and be role models for the children in the future and enthuse their love of reading even more.



We have also linked with a famous publicist and next Wednesday all year groups will be taking part in an online virtual event with **Baroness Floella Benjamin.** This is another exciting opportunity and ties in with Windrush Day, which is celebrated on 22nd June. Celebrated annually on the same date, this day honours the contributions of the Windrush generation and their descendants to British society. Windrush Day commemorates the arrival of the MV Empire Windrush at Tilbury Docks in 1948, bringing passengers from the Caribbean to the UK. This event marked the beginning of significant migration from the Caribbean, which greatly enriched British culture and society. Dame Floella Benjamin will be reading her popular memoir book 'Coming to England' to the children. The book follows ten-year-old Floella as she and her family set sail from the Caribbean to a new life in London. Alone on a huge ship for two weeks, then tumbled into a cold and unfriendly London, coming to England wasn't at all what Floella had expected . . . What will her new school be like? Will she meet the Queen? Filled with optimism and joy, yet deeply personal and relevant, young children will resonate with Floella's experiences of moving home and making friends...she is a truly inspirational speaker and we are also very excited to have the opportunity to take part in a Q and A session with her!
