





Our Intent

At Mereside Primary Academy the Phonics Curriculum enables our pupils to learn together and achieve together' by helping them become confident readers. We value reading as a key life skill and are dedicated to enabling our pupils to become lifelong readers. We acknowledge that children need to be taught the key skills in segmenting and blending to be equipped with the knowledge to be able to complete the phonics check at the end of year 1. We also value and encourage the pupils to read for enjoyment and recognise that this starts with the foundations of acquiring letter sounds, segmenting and blending skills. Evidence has shown that a structured systematic approach to the delivery of phonics, is the most effective. We follow the 'Read Write Inc' accredited scheme, to support our delivery. This also aligns with our book scheme, to ensure that children are reading books which enhances their knowledge of phonics in context. The systematic teaching of phonics has a high priority throughout Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1. We also ensure that phonics is continued into KS2 and that assessments are completed to ensure a secure understanding to support spellings and independent writing.
