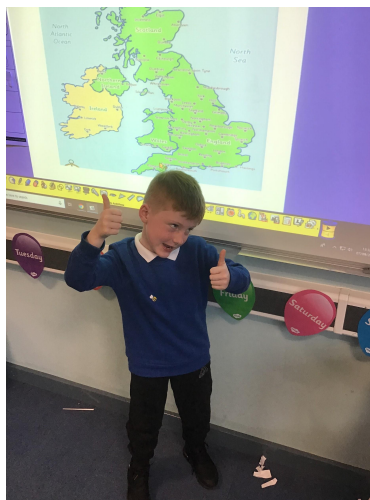
Welcome to 1/2S!

Hello, I am Mr Sutton the class teacher. Mrs Duxbury our Teaching Assistant will be supporting us in class too.

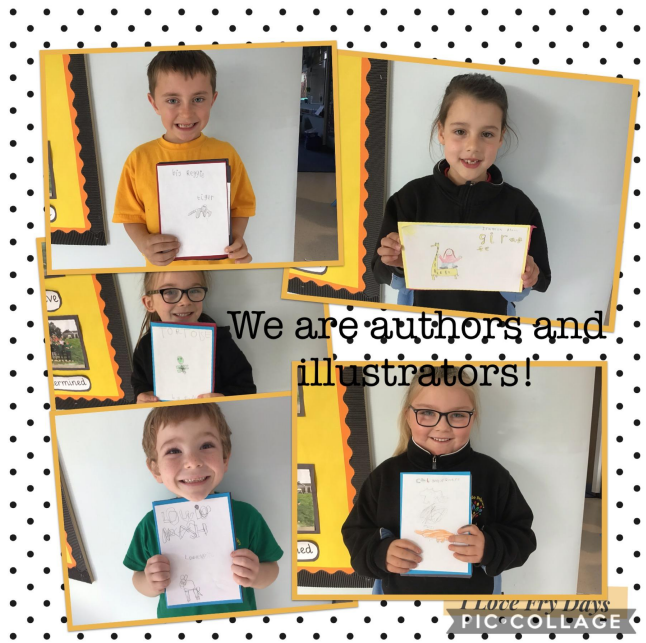
