At Meynell Primary School children are entitled to 15 or 30 hours of free education each week term time only, taken flexibly in various combinations of full and part days. For those that require it an additional top up hour above the 15 or 30 hours may be available.

Delivery of the 15 hours free entitlement

Parents choose between am, or pm sessions or two longer days.
30 hours are Monday to Friday 8.20am until 2.20pm.

The sessions the school offers are:

- **Morning session:** 8.20am - 11.20am
 - **Afternoon session:** 12.20pm - 3.20pm
 - **Full days (2 sessions):** 8.20am - 2.20pm, children stay for lunch
 - **Two longer days - 15 hours (Monday & Tuesday or Thursday & Friday):** 8.00am - 3.30pm, children stay for lunch

Additional hours

Sometimes the option of extending the 15/30 hours free entitlement is needed. Parents are required to pre-book and pay for additional provision, through Parent Pay, which is a top up hour between 2.20 and 3.20pm.

The additional hour at the end of the school day will be offered space permitting and will be charged as below.

Conditions of offering additional hours and charging

- Charges must cover the cost of delivering the service, any profits being re-invested in the school.
 - Payments are to be made parent pay in advance.

Charging

Charges for sessions are as follows:

- **Session costs £5.61 per hour 3-4 year old**
- **Session costs £8.28 per hour 2-3 year old**
