Home School Agreement – January 2021

At Micklefield CE Primary School we aim to maintain a secure, caring and stimulating environment in which children are encouraged to have respect for themselves and each other. This document has been created to run alongside our Behaviour Addendum to ensure everyone understands the part they play in keeping everyone safe.

As a school we agree to:

- Understand that this is a tricky situation for all involved and treat parents and pupils kindly and with respect.
- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in accordance with LA and Government guidance.
- Adhere to social distancing rules as much as possible and encourage others to do so.
- Give daily reminders to all pupils about how school is different at the moment.
- Follow the behaviour policy and the addendum clearly and consistently including rewards and sanctions
- Provide a curriculum which meets the needs of all learners for their mental health, wellbeing and academic needs.
- Contact you immediately if your child shows symptoms of Covid-19
- Inform you if a child or adult in your child's group tests positive for Covid-19 as this means that you will all need to isolate
- Continue to provide clear and open communication between home and school.

Parents/Carers, by sending my child to school I agree to:

- Understand that this is a tricky situation for all involved and treat staff, other parents and pupils kindly and with respect.
- Make sure the school has the most up to date contact and medical information for my child.
- Understand that I cannot enter the school building without prior consent.
- Talk to my child before they attend about what to expect and how it will be different.
- Talk to my child about social distancing and support them in understanding why it is so important.
- Not bring my child to school if they or anyone in the household shows symptoms of Covid-19, isolate for 10 days, arrange a test and let school know the outcome.
- If my child or another child or an adult from my child's group tests positive for Covid-19, I will collect my child immediately after being informed by the school.
- Support the school in the use of the behaviour policy and in particular the behaviour addendum.
- Strictly and conscientiously follow entry and exit procedures and staggered times using social distancing, and encourage others to do so.

- Do not allow my child to bring things from home, apart from their coat, a refillable water bottle, reading book and packed lunch if required.
- Ensure my child wears school uniform as much as possible and PE kit when required and has clean clothes every day.
- Read all letters and emails sent by the school.
- Encourage my child to have good hand and respiratory hygiene.
- Know the staff in school may take my child's temperature if they become unwell.
- Understand that all children are expected to follow all expectations and instructions given by ANY adult in school and understand that if they don't they may be sent home until they can be safe.

Pupils, by coming to school I agree to:

- Understand that this is a tricky situation for all involved and treat each other, staff and other children kindly and with respect.
- Talk to my parents/carers before attending school about how school will look and feel different.
- Talk to my parents/carers about social distancing and try to understand why it is so important.
- Follow social distancing rules in school, in the playground and on the school field.
- Follow the behaviour policy and in particular the new behaviour rules put in place to keep us safe.
- Not bring things from home apart from my coat, water bottle, reading book and packed lunch if I have one.
- Only mix with the other children in my group.
- Follow good hand hygiene, washing my hands regularly with soap and water for 20 seconds or using the hand sanitiser given to me.
- Follow good respiratory hygiene, coughing and sneezing in to a tissue or the crook of my elbow, making sure I put the tissue straight in the bin.
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell
- Follow all expectations and instructions given by ANY adult in school and understand that if I don't, I may be sent home until I can stay safe.
