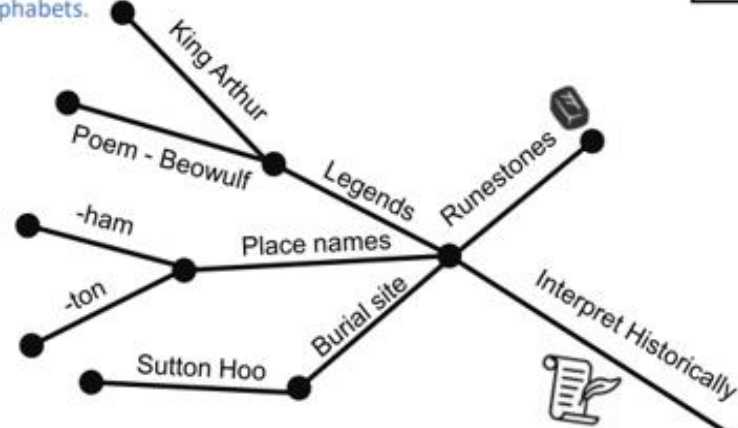


Legend – A story set in human history, which historians haven't been able to prove actually happened.

Runestones – Stones bearing ancient alphabets.

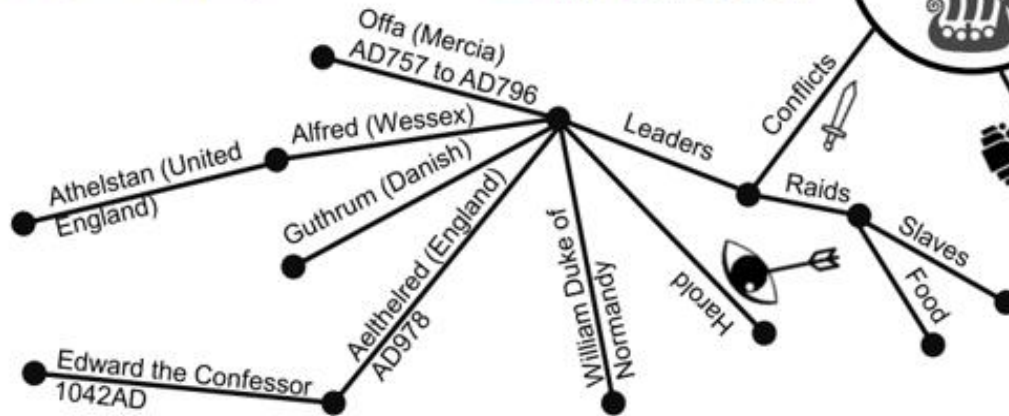


Revenge – To carry out a punishment in a resentful way.

Massacre – The murder of a large number of people.

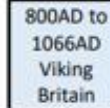
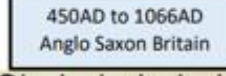
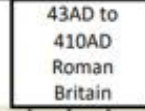
Confessor – A priest who hears confessions.
