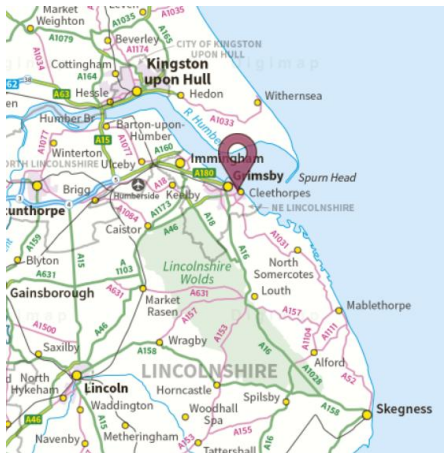


## Y2 Where would you rather live: Cleethorpes or Cairo?

**Pyramid:** A monument built in Egypt

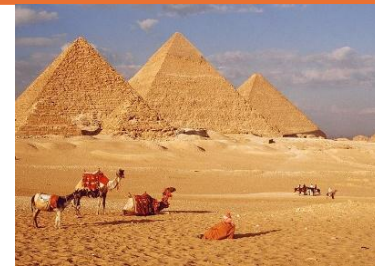
**Densely:** Lots of people living in one area

**Transport:** How to move from place to place

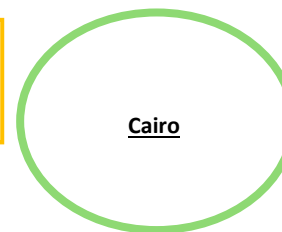
**Valley:** A low area of land between hills
