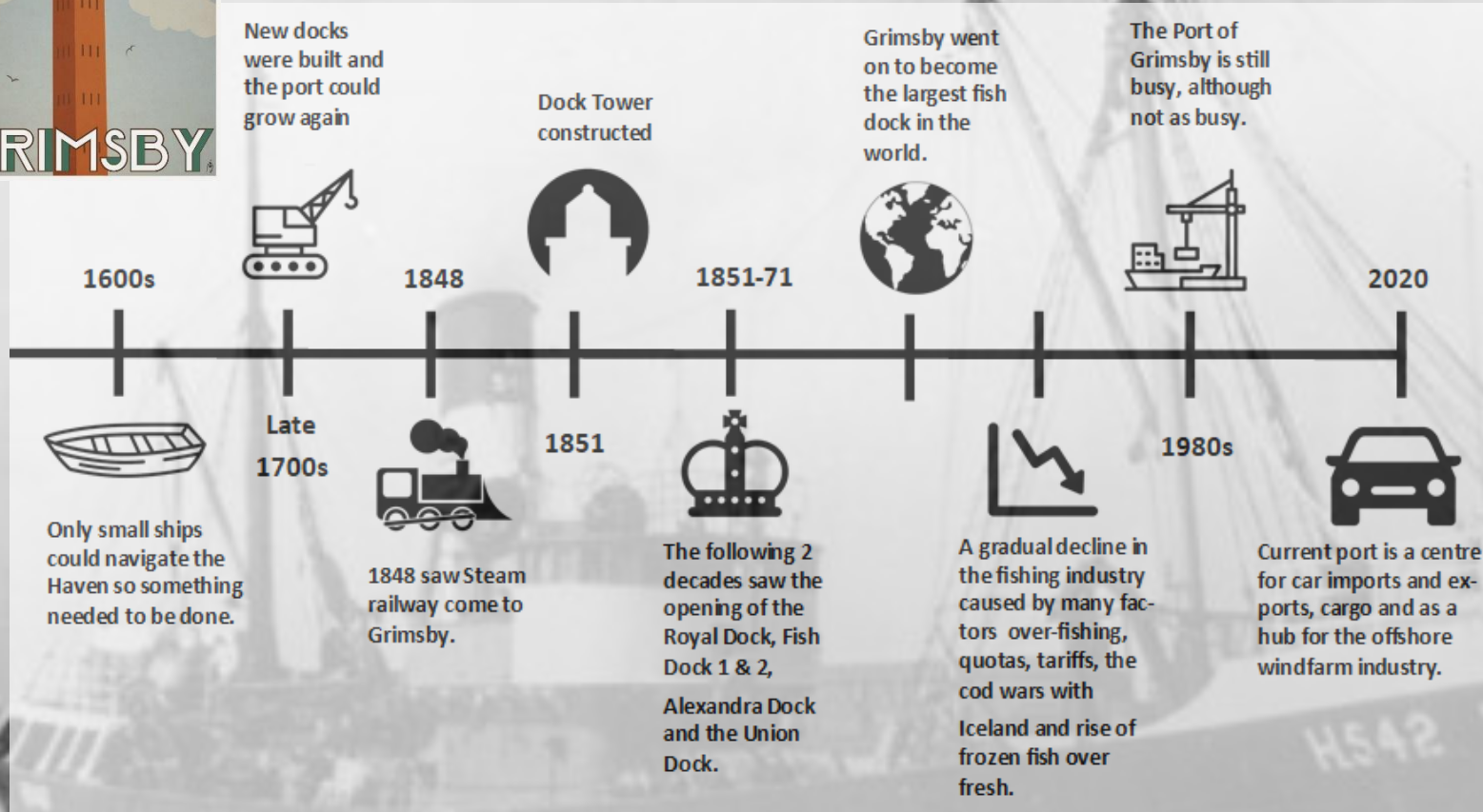


## How did Grimsby become 'GREAT Grimsby'?

<b>medieval</b>	The period between the end of the Roman Empire in 476 AD and 1500 AD
<b>industry</b>	The collecting of raw materials to produce a product to sell.
<b>magnates</b>	A magnate is someone who has earned a lot of money from a particular business or industry.
<b>navigate</b>	Choosing a course that is safe to follow.
<b>amenities</b>	Useful facilities or services.
<b>constructed</b>	Built or made.
<b>decades</b>	A decade is a period of ten years.
<b>investment</b>	The activity of investing money into a business, industry or area.
<b>prosperous</b>	People, places and economies that are rich and successful.
<b>decline</b>	If something declines, it becomes less in quantity, importance or strength.
