Activity outline	To understand a character's feelings. To be able to describe a character's outward appearance.	To know the story Augustus and his smile. Watch the story being read out loud. What to do	Look at the picture on the first page of the tiger without his smile. Using an outline of a tiger, write words to describe the tiger's feelings inside the outline.	Watch the story being told. If needed, stop at various points to discuss what has happened so far. Watch the rest of the video. Discuss what happened in the story.	Re-watch the story and discuss if you can or think about the events and what happens at the end. Read each question and find the answer in the story. Write your answers. Check them.	Using the ideas in the story, wrote your own ending. You can use the puddle idea or he could see his reflection in the river etc. EG Augustus had just about to give up. He walked to the river's edge...	Read yesterday's ending. If you have not finished it you can finish it today. If you have finished spend a little but of time to improve it. What can you add? Have you used super word? Have you included an expanded noun phrase?
Possible questions	What does the tiger look like? How does he feel?	What is the story called? Who is the main character? What has happened so far?	What happened at the beginning? What happened at the end?	What could happen at the end? How could we end the story with a reflection?	How can you improve your writing? What can be added? What might you need to change?
