What to do	Knowledge has a beginning but it has no end. In order to agree or disagree we will improve our general knowledge this week. You need to pick something that you want to learn about eg countries, a time in history, scientific understanding, nature etc. Now record some questions, things you want to find out. Record these on the record sheet.	Read your questions from yesterday. Use a search engine such as Google to find the answers to your questions. Write the information you find on the right hand side of the questions. You can use notes. Repeat until you have answered all of your questions. Eg Google – how is a rainbow made How is a cloud formed?	Today you need to use the notes you made to produce fact sheet. For example let's say you researched rainbows.
