Activity outline	Can I plan my own story for a younger reader? This week you will be writing your own story about being happy.	Can I write my own story beginning? Use your story plan to start writing your story.	Can I develop my story? Continue to write your story.	Can I end my story? Finish writing your story.	Can I improve my writing? Today you will improve your story.
What to do	You can adapt the story about Augustus or write your own story about looking for and finding things that make your character happy or find their smile. Plan your story using notes (key words) include things that your character sees along the way eg butterflies, birds, streams, sunshine. You can of course add your own ideas but we would like you to write a story about finding happiness or a smile.	Today you need to start writing your story. Remember to use good sentence starters and keep it interesting. If you get stuck remember the story about Augustus or re-watch to get some ideas. What can your character see next? They may not realise that it makes them happy until the end.	Today you need to start by reading your plan from Monday. Next you need to read the story beginning that you wrote yesterday. Now carry on. Remember to check each sentence as you write it. Can you start your sentences in different way? Do not start them they, they, they, they.	Now you need to finish your story. What does the character learn at the end of the story? Is it a good ending? Has the character got a way of being happy or smiling now? Have you solved the problem?	Read yesterday's ending. If you have not finished it you can finish it today. If you have finished spend a little but of time to improve it. What can you add? Have you used super word? Have you included an expanded noun phrase?
Possible questions	What is the story called? Who is the main character? What will happened? What will happen at the beginning? What will happen at the end? How could we end the story with a reflection?	How will you start your story? Who is the character? What is the problem?	What did you write yesterday? What happens next? What sentence starters can you use?	Have you used good words? Have you read it to check that it makes sense?	How can you improve your writing? What can be added? What might you need to change? Is your punctuation correct?
