#### Autumn Term

Our theme this term will be: 'All About Me'.

Our Enquiry question will be...

What do I like about being Me?

#### Phonics and Maths

Phonics - This term children will be introduced to phonics through Read Write Inc. Children will learn 4 new sounds a week.

Maths - Matching & Sorting.

Children will explore comparing different amounts as well as comparing size mass and capacity.

### We will be learning:

Personal, Social & Emotional Development: Making new friends, daily routines, classroom rules, managing our beahviour.

Communication & Language Development: Story time, Nursery Rhyme Challenge, Carpet time.

Physical Development: PE, Dough Disco, Wake up Shake Up, Writing, Funky Fingers.

Literacy: Phonics, initial mark making recognising own name and writing own name.

Mathematics: Matching and Sorting, Recognising numbers to 5.

Understanding the World: Seasons/Autumn, Our School, Birthdays, Human Body, Our Senses.

Expressive Art & Design: Portraits, Family Pictures, Nature Crafts, Construction, Colour making, Pizza faces!
