Keeping our children safe: Bicycles and Dogs

As summer arrives, we are very aware that more children will be riding their bikes to and from school. We would like to take this opportunity to remind all, that bikes and scooters should be dismounted on entry through the front gates and mounted on the pavement on leaving. This is for the safety of all, especially during our busy periods.

We recognise that dogs are an important part of family life for many in our school community, and are often included in day-to-day activities such as walking children to and from school. However, others may find their presence stressful, even frightening particularly with younger children, and even well-behaved dogs can behave unpredictably when placed in a busy, noisy and crowded environment. We therefore respectfully request that dogs are kept outside the school grounds.
