Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Children will know how to play partner games.

Physical Development

Literacy

- Ochildren will know the logos for local supermarkets and shops.
- We will read and re-read a selection of books to engage in conversations about the story, develop understanding and learn new vo-cabulary.
- Children will spot and suggest rhymes, as well as clap syllables in a word.
 - Children will begin to know initial sounds, s,a,t,p,i,n.

Mathematics

- Children will count to in correspondence to 5.
- Children will identify the sequence of a pattern.
 - ♦ Children will show finger numbers to 3
 - ♦ Children will create AB patterns

Understanding the World

- ♦ Children will know that some people celebrate Diwali.
- Children will know that some people celebrate Christmas.
- ♦ When cooking, cooling and heating children will know that materials change.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will do large scale drawings/paintings to create individual and group art work.
