Communication and Language

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will read and re read a selection of books to engage in conversations about the story,

develop an understanding and learn new vocabulary.

♦ Children will know how to draw horizontal lines.

<u>Mathematics</u>

Children will be able to count to 5.
We will learn how to sort objects by colour, size and shape.

♦ Begin to create AB patterns.
