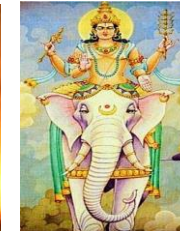
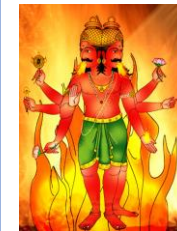
## Hinduism
