Dear Parents and Carers

It gives me great pleasure to share the reopening plans for March. Middlethorpe Primary Academy will reopen for all children from Nursery to Year 6 on **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March**. Please read this letter carefully to ensure that you and your child are ready.

All arrangements will remain the same as before Christmas including drop off and pick up times.

**We ask that you do not** arrive before the drop off time. Doors will be opened at the drop off time, therefore, there is no need to arrive earlier than this as we must avoid groups of people on the school site.

If you are waiting for the doors to open you have arrived too early and should not be on site.

We ask that only one adult drops off and collects your child from school. If you have pre-school children we ask that they remain close to the adult at all times whilst they are on site. **We urge all parents and carers to maintain social distance when dropping children off at school. All adults must wear a face mask when on site.**

As a school, we are continuing to follow recommendations from the DfE to minimise the risk of the virus spreading and to keep the children and staff as safe as possible. We ask that:

- Children are not sent to school if they have Covid 19 symptoms
- Children are not sent to school if someone they live with has Covid 19 symptoms or has tested positive
- Children are not sent to school if they have been notified to isolate

**We urge all parents and carers to support us in this for the safety of all children and staff.**

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your commitment to home learning. It has been lovely to see the children connecting in live lessons and producing some amazing remote learning.

We look forward to welcoming everyone back to school on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March.
