### Important people

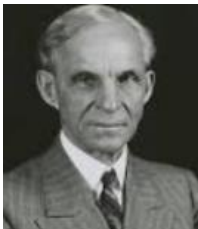
**Amelia Earhart**

1781-1848  
Inventor of the first steam engine.  
'Blucher' 1814  
'Rocket' 1828

1863-1947  
Creator of the Ford Model T car  
and founder of the  
Ford Motor Company



**1896**  
The first powered aircraft

**1903**  
The Wright Brothers first  
manned flight

**1927**  
Charles Lindbergh flies across  
the Atlantic

**1937**  
Amelia Earhart attempts to fly  
around the world

**1969**  
Boeing 747 was made
