Purpose of writing in KS1

- Entertain stories including retells, descriptions, poetry, in-character or role
- Inform letters and instructions

Purpose of writing in LKS2

- Entertain stories, descriptions, poetry, characters/settings
- Inform explanations, recounts, letters, biographies, newspaper articles
- Persuade advertising, speeches and posters

Purpose of writing in UKS2

- Entertain narratives, descriptions, poetry, characters/settings
- Inform reports, recounts, biographies, newspaper articles, essays
- Persuade advertising, letters, speeches, campaigns
- Discuss balanced arguments, and reviews.

- Links across year groups for retrieval of knowledge
