Words	Meaning
village	A group of houses and buildings, smaller than a town and situated in the countryside.
town	A built-up area that is larger than a village and generally smaller than a city.
city	A large town.
country	A nation with its own government, occupying a particular area.
locality	An area or neighbourhood.
population	The number of people who live in a place.
location	A particular place or position.
capital	The city or town that functions as the base of government of a country or region.
region	An area, especially part of a country or the world having definable characteristics but not always fixed boundaries.
physical features	Natural features of a specific location.
human features	Man-made features of a specific location.
similarities	A similar feature or aspect.
differences	Features that are not the same.
