


Year 1 Autumn 1 History: How has transport changed over time?

George Stephenson 1781-1848 Inventor of the first steam engine. 'Blucher' 1814 'Rocket' 1828



Wilbur and Orville Wright

American brothers who built and flew the first powered Aircraft, named Flyer, on 17th December 1903.




Amelia Earhart

1897-1937 (disappeared)
A pilot who was the first female aviator to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean. She later attempted to fly around the world.



Henry Ford 1863-1947

Creator of the Ford Model T car and founder of the Ford Motor Company
