

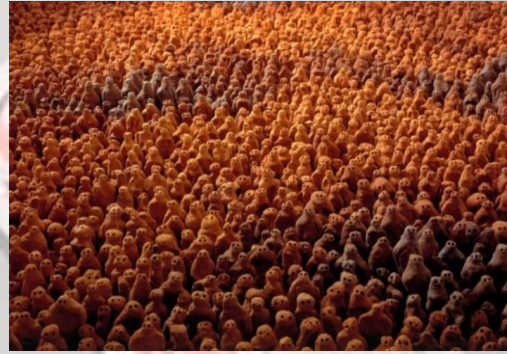

Vocabulary	Definition
<u>Abstract</u>	Using shapes, colours and marks to produce art
<u>Sculpture</u>	Forming solid objects to represent a person or idea
<u>3-Dimensional</u>	A solid object that has height, depth and length
<u>Assemblage</u>	A collection of objects put together
<u>Collage</u>	Art made by sticking different materials such as fabric or paper onto a backing
<u>Mould</u>	To form an object out of a malleable material
<u>Carve</u>	To make something by cutting into it
<u>Chisel</u>	A tool with a long metal blade
