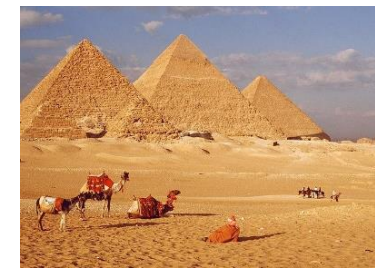


Y2 T3 Where would you rather live: Cleethorpes or Cairo?

It is situated in the North of Egypt on the River Nile.

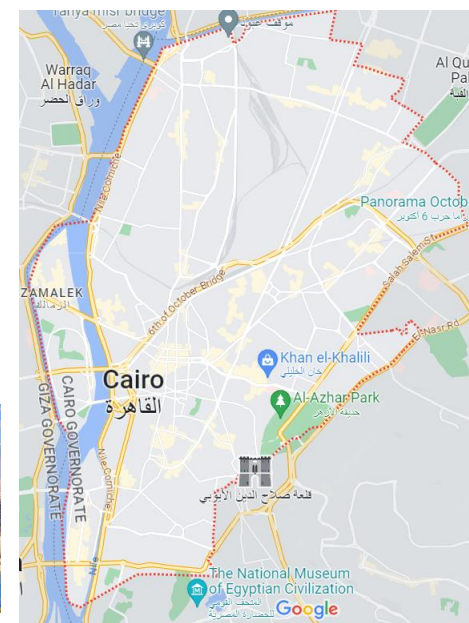
Cairo is densely populated and has a population of 11 million people.

Manufacturing: The process of making goods

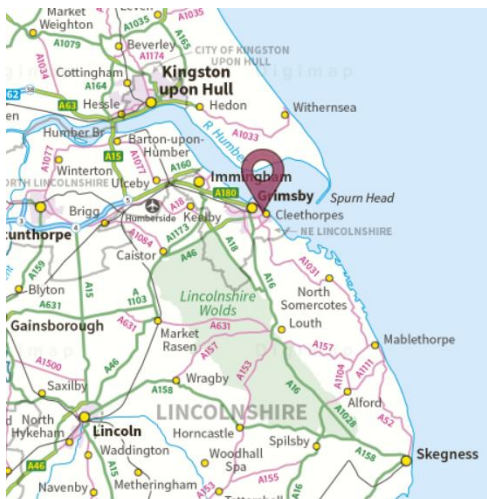
Pyramid: A monument built in Egypt
