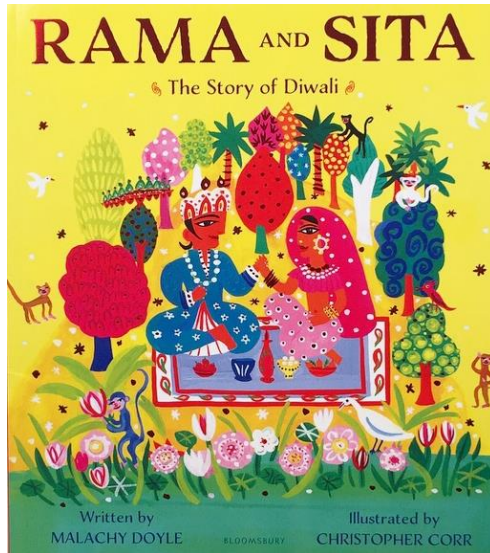
Brahman	supreme spirit of the Hindu faith

celebrations	special enjoyable event organised for a reason
community	all the people who live in a particular area or community
miracle	surprising and unexpected event
belief	feeling of certainty that something exists, is true, or is good
interpretation	an opinion about what something means
ritual	a religious service or other ceremony which involves a series of actions performed in a fixed order
deity	a god or goddess
tri-murti	triad of the three gods Brahma, Vishnu, and Shiva
omnipresent	something that is present everywhere or seems to be always present

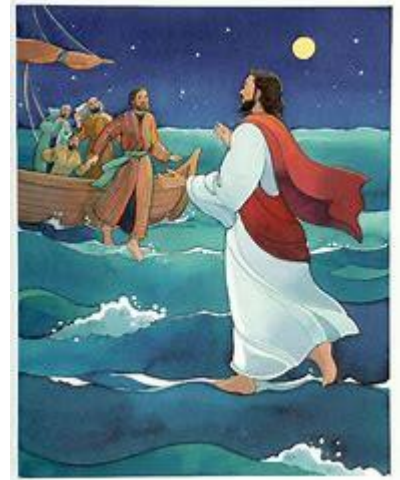
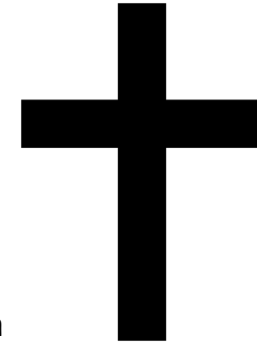
