Welcome back, I hope you have all had a lovely half term and are rearing to go this term.

Our knowledge based curriculum places powerful knowledge at its heart. The content has been chosen and carefully sequenced to build on prior learning while taking into account any gaps the children may have due to effects of the pandemic. Each half term there will be a different subject focus. This half term the whole school will be focussing on Geography. To support children in their learning we have developed Knowledge Organisers for Geography and Science. Knowledge Organisers help children to learn and retain the essential knowledge that they are taught so that they are then able to recall it. Each Knowledge Organiser includes key dates, people, vocabulary, definitions, events and contextual or technical information that we want the children to know by heart by the end of the topic. Knowledge Organisers for each class can be found on the website but will also be stuck into the children's home learning books as well as being pinned to the Year 5 noticeboard in the corridor for you to support them in learning the essential knowledge. We expect the majority of children to be able to recall all of the information on the Knowledge Organiser by the end of a half term.
