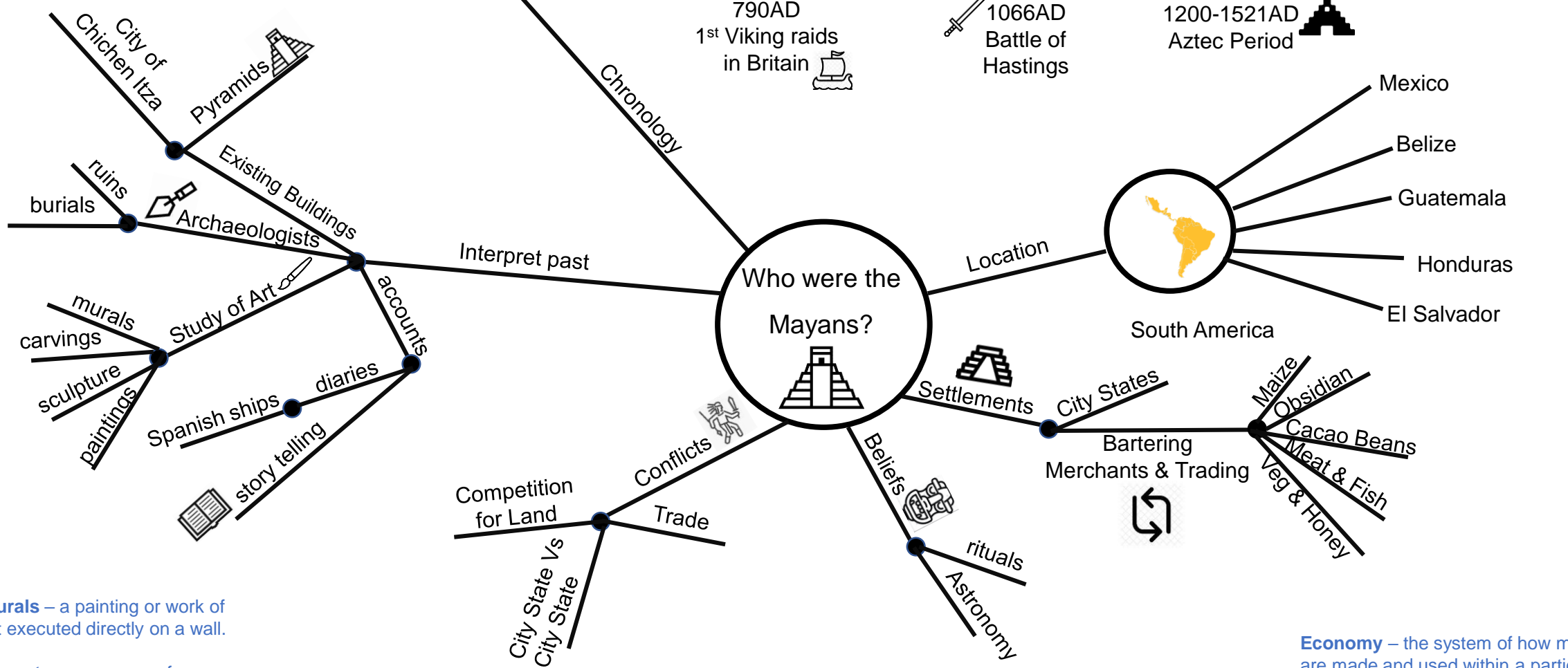
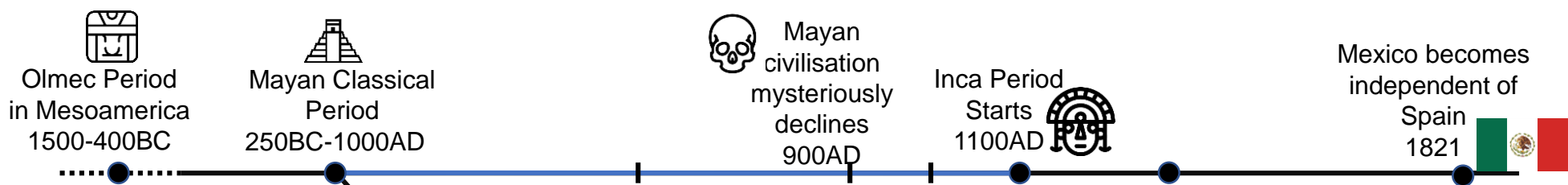


Maya – a member of the native people of Yucatan in Central America.
