Method of allocating places

The Governing Body has determined that there will be one intake for the whole of the school year. This means that all children, whether summer or winter born, start Foundation Stage 1 (FS1) in September.

There are 26 places available in each of the am and pm sessions for September 2024 within a 15 hour per week entitlement. Of those part time places 10 in each session will be reserved for those entitled to a 30-hour week. If the number of applicants does not exceed this number, the School Governors will admit all applicants. The Governors will also endeavour to admit more than the reserved ten 30-hour places if required.

The Governing Body will make every effort to offer children the opportunity to take up more of their flexible entitlement by booking extra sessions.

The Governors have determined that if the demand for places at Middleton Parish Church School FS1 exceeds the number of places available (see above), priority will be given to the categories listed below, in the priority order shown.

If you feel any of the categories apply to your child's circumstances, *please put this on the application form,* and if necessary, ask your health visitor, social worker or doctor to write to the school to support your view. Any information given will be treated in confidence by the school.

Priority One

Children who are looked after by the Local Authority/Children who have medical or social needs:

Priority for admission will be given to any child where there is evidence of that child having a medical or psychological difficulty which is likely to affect his or her learning, providing the nursery is able to support the child's particular needs. There must be written supporting evidence either from the Consultant Community Paediatrician, the Clinical Psychologist or the Educational Psychology Service.

Priority Two

Any child who has a sibling attending Middleton Parish Church School in Years R-Y5. Siblings include step, half, foster and adopted brothers or sisters living at the same address and full brother or sister living apart.

Priority Three

Children who are regular attendees at any of the Christian Churches within the parish of the joint benefice of St Leonard's and St John's Thornham.

Regular attendance is normally taken to mean a minimum of fortnightly attendance at church at public worship for at least the year prior to 1st September in the year before admission to the school. Evidence of infant baptism or dedication of the child and of regular attendance of parent(s)/guardian(s) must be provided by a member of the clergy or other designated church officer on the form provided.

Priority Four

Children who live within the Parish of St Leonard's and St John's Thornham.

Priority Five – Remaining Places

After the above priority cases, if there are still vacancies, other children whose parents have applied for places at Middleton Parish Church School FS1 will be allocated places by proximity of the child's home to the school (measured using LA software which is also used for Reception Admissions), with those living nearer being accorded the higher priority until the nursery places are all allocated.

Admission to Middleton Parish Church School Foundation Stage 1 Class does not guarantee admission to our Reception (FS2) class.

Children who are not admitted will have their name placed on a waiting list. The names on this waiting list will be in the order of the admissions criteria. Since the date of application cannot be a criterion for the order of names on the waiting list, late applicants for the school will be slotted into the order according to the extent to which they meet the criteria. Thus it is possible for a child who moves into the area later to have a higher priority than one who has been on the waiting list for some time. If a place becomes available within the admission number, the child whose name is at the top of the list will be offered a place.

Appeals. Parents do not have the right to appeal the decision made on Foundation Stage 1 (Nursery) applications.

Application for a FS1 (NURSERY) place at Middleton Parish Church School from Sept 2024 This application form must be returned to the school by end January 24. You will be notified in due course if a place has been allocated for your child.
