Phonics

This half term in phonics, we are going to be looking at instrumental sounds. We are going to be tuning into the sounds that different instruments make and trying to remember the sounds that we have heard.

Literacy

We will be using the weather and the change of seasons as our inspiration for our next stories in class. Any stories you enjoy or know that connect with this please do not hesitate to send us your ideas. It could be your child's favourite book that involves Autumn or Winter. I know my favourite stories involve snow so keep an eye out for them this term.

Understanding the World Autumn is here and winter is fast approaching. This half term we will be learning all about how the seasons change and how this affects the weather. We will be looking at the change in temperature and how things freeze during the colder months. Trees change colour and leaves fall. We will be looking closely at nature and how plants and animals are

affected.

<u>Reading</u> Story time

At the end of every day, we all participate in a class story time. This is a wonderful end to a busy day and provides a calm transition from school to home. Story time is an important aspect of our reading curriculum and is a vital aspect of developing young children's language skills.

Reading Books

Children will be sent home with a book each week. Inside each book there are questions you can use to help develop the book with your child. We change books generally on a Monday but if your child needs a change of book please just let us know. The idea is to enjoy the book

together pointing out the main parts and pictures as you read. Allow your child to handle the book and turn the pages, and track the

words with your finger for a few pages to show the directionality of the text. You can ask children what might happen next and follow any interests that come from reading the book. Children will have the choice on a Monday to change their book with others we have in class. They can always keep the same book for more than one week if they are enjoying it. Reading is a key to progression in all areas of school life so

enjoy.
