

Attendance is Important!

How you can support and encourage you child to have excellent attendance an punctuality?

- Show your child that you think school is very important and that they should attend every day if they are well.
- Praise your child's achievements and get them into good habits from an early age.
- Take time to talk to your children about school and what they have done that day.
- Do not keep your child at home if your child is worried or there is a problem. Bring them to school and ask for a meeting to discuss this. The more time your child is absent from school, the harder it will be for them to return.
- Make sure your child has a good nights sleep and wakes up ready for the school day.
- Talk to the class teacher or a member of staff if there is a problem or there are difficulties for your child to attend regular.
