## English Reading

This half term in reading, we are going to be reading a text called Goldilocks and the Three Bears and Little Red Riding Hood. We will be exploring retrieval and inference questions and sequencing events.



#### Writing

In writing, we are going to be exploring features of a short narrative. We will then be sequencing and writing Goldilocks and the Three Bears. When we look at the story of Little Red Riding Hood we will be writing our own versions of this story and making simple changes, such as to the characters we choose or the setting in which the story is set.


### **Outdoor Shoes**

## **Reading Books and GORead!**

All children take one or two books home that support the phonics learning taking place in class. Some children will also receive a share together book; these books contain words that cannot be decoded using phonics knowledge but they are great to support vocabulary development. Please share these books with your child.

All books should come into school and back home each day to maximise reading opportunities. Please ensure that you log your child's reading each time they read. Staff in school can then see that a book is finished and will change that book. Books are changed once each week providing they have been read.
