


English Reading

This half term in reading, we will be approaching reading in a different way. With every new text, we will begin by orientating ourselves to the text and really getting to know it, before focusing on a different reading skill each day to develop these skills over the weeks and year.

Writing

In Writing, we will be using the story The Egyptian Cinderella as a stimulus for writing our own narrative. We will then focus on writing a letter based around the story 'Temple Cat.'

History

This half term, we are exploring Ancient Egypt through our topic 'What is a pyramid?' Children will develop their skills of chronology throughout this unit, along with learning about Ancient Egyptian society, Gods and Goddesses, mummification, pyramids, and hieroglyphics. Children will compare and understand the impact of the Ancient Egyptians on modern life.



P.E and Forest School

P.E and Forest School is on a Tuesday for Year 3. Our P.E. unit this half term is hockey! Children should ensure they wear the correct outdoor kit on a Tuesday and bring their wellies in a named plastic carrier bag.

PSHE

Our Heart Smart topic is 'Too Much Selfie Isn't Healthy!' We will be exploring the importance of others and how to love them well.



Religious Education

In R.E. our topic is 'Jesus, the man who changed lives.' In this unit, we will explore how as Christians, we believe that Jesus has the power to change people's lives. We will understand that choosing to follow Jesus is not an easy option, and explore how people's lives today are transformed by Jesus.



Maths

To start the half term, we will continue to explore multiplication and division, with a focus on multiplying and dividing 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, with and without an exchange. We will then begin to learn about length and perimeter, with a focus on measuring in metres, centimetres and millimetres.

Please ensure children are logging on to TTRS at least once a week to help consolidate the 3s, 4s and 8 times tables that children are expected to know by the end of Year 3.
