Reading

This half term in reading, children will read a variety of different texts to answer comprehension questions.

Writing

In writing, we will be using our knowledge of rivers from Geography to write a poem using a range of Year 4 grammar features alongside similes, metaphors and personification.



Homework

As shared on dojo, homework will be sent out each Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Tasks will take the children no longer than ten minutes and must be completed each night and returned the next day to help support our learning in class.



Science

Our science topic this term is 'States of matter'. We will be learning how to:

- Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.
- observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius.
- identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature

Reading

This half term we will be reading 'Onyeka and the academy of the sun'.

A debut children's novel packed full of memorable characters, Onyeka and the Academy of the Sun is the effervescent story of a British-Nigerian girl who discovers her curls have psychokinetic abilities and the thrilling adventures she undertakes with her new-found superhero friends.

Reading Books and GORead!

Our new class libraries have been set and are ready to go for the year ahead and all children should now have a reading book.

Should children have a home reading book they would like to read, please send it into school for teachers to check it provides enough challenge to support progression in reading – teachers will then add this book to GORead.

Adults in school will read with all children at least once a week. We ask that children read at home daily.

All reading should be recorded on GORead in order for children to earn maximum gems! Problem words/new vocabulary can be added on go read alongside in vocabulary books.

History

In History, our focus question is, 'What does the name Middleton mean?' Within this topic, children will learn about Anglo-Saxon settlements in England.
