






MOMENTS MATTER, ATTENDANCE COUNTS.

Smarter and Safer Parking



If you need to drive your child to school:

For the safety of your child, their friends, and the local community we ask that you park safely, legally and considerately around schools.

As you are aware, new parking restrictions were introduced on Gainsborough Way during the February half term.

Unfortunately we are still seeing cars parking in the zones where parking/waiting is not allowed, including in front of our emergency gates. Parking Enforcement Officers are patrolling the area and may issue fixed penalty fines.

We have also seen some very irresponsible behaviour with parents stopping their cars in the middle of the crossing point outside the school pedestrian gate and letting children out of the car. Not only are they endangering the lives of their own children but also causing an obstruction to other road users.

Donations can be handed into the office, and your kind donations are greatly appreciated. Thank you!




Book Week at Millbrook
