



Financial Worries?

If you are experiencing financial difficulties at the moment Citizens Advice are running a drop in session at Freshbrook Church on Tuesday 6th February from 1.30pm -4.00pm

If you receive certain benefits you may be entitled to Free School Meals —

- Income support
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and your household annual income is less than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit (provided your household annual income is less than £7,400 after tax and not including any benefits you get)

- -Increase your income through unclaimed benefits or grants -Reduce your outgoings through budgeting, accessing lower social tariffs and savvy shopping
- -Reduce energy usage -Access debt advice
