Being Healthy at Millbrook

Healthy Snacks !

Every day all infant children receive fruit for morning snack provided by the Government Infant Fruit Scheme and Millbrook provides a healthy snack for children in KS2.

Please may we remind you that you should only provide your child with a healthy snack eg fruit, cheese, carrot sticks.

Information from the Health Protection Agency on the current out break of Measles -

Measles – key facts

100 susceptible people
(e.g. not vaccinated against measles)



+ Measles
virus

About 90 people will catch measles,
7 with complications



- measles is caused by a virus that spreads very easily. One case of measles can infect 9 out of 10 of unvaccinated close contacts
- transmitted through the respiratory route (airborne or droplet spread) or by direct contact with the nasal or throat secretions of infected persons
- incubation period: 10 to 12 days from exposure to onset of symptoms, but can vary from 7 to 21 days
- infectious period: 4 days before onset of rash to 4 days after onset of rash (NB rash counts as Day 0)
