Uniform

We have high expectations for all our children and are proud of our school uniform and logo. Wearing the school uniform is one obvious symbol that the children share these expectations. Extremes of fashion in clothes, footwear or hair styles are neither acceptable nor appropriate for school. Shoes should be appropriate and for your child's safety high heels, sling backs or flipflops should not be worn. Long hair must be tied back at all times.

Jewellery

Jewellery should not be worn to school. The exceptions to this rule can be found on the school uniform policy.
