- Participate in discussions concerning behaviour, attitudes to learning, progress and attainment
- Ensure correct school uniform is worn at all times, including PE kit uniform
- Collect their child from school at the correct times
- Give careful consideration to the content children see online and ensure children are not allowed to access non-age appropriate social media
