Residential Visits	Parents are required to meet the full cost of the
	residential visit. Where the school is in receipt of
	pupil premium funding in respect of a child, the cost

Individual Instrumental Music Tuitian	overall cost, such activities may have to be cancelled.
Individual Instrumental Music Tuition	Where the school provides an 'outside' tutor, parents
	will be charged for the tuition. 'Outside' tuition fees
	may be reduced where the school is in receipt of
	pupil premium funding in respect of a child, when the
	cost may be supported partly or fully from that
	funding.
Ingredients/materials for practical	Parents are encouraged to provide materials for
subjects	practical subjects, but no child will be disadvantaged
	because of parents' inability/reluctance to pay. Where
	necessary, school will pay the cost of this.
Swimming Lessons	Parents are requested to provide a voluntary
	contribution towards swimming lessons provided for
	their child. Once the child is able to swim 25m and
	meets the National Curriculum requirements then, if
	the parent does not make a contribution, the child will
	no longer go swimming. All additional costs of
	swimming will be covered by the school
Trips and Visits during the school day	Parents may be requested to make a voluntary
	contribution towards the costs of trips/visits or
	education experiences provided during the school
	day. The school is not able to provide these activities
	from within the main school budget and if sufficient
	voluntary contributions are not received then the
	trip/visit/educational activity might have to be
	cancelled. Where the school is in receipt of pupil
	premium funding in respect of a child, the cost may
	be supported partly or fully from that funding, by prior
	agreement with the Head Teacher. Those who do not
	make a voluntary contribution will not be excluded
	from the trip/visit/education activity if it proceeds.
Lost school equipment, books, etc	Parents may be requested to replace school
	equipment, books, etc. which have been lost by their
	child.
Breakages and damages to school	Wilful damage to school buildings or property by a
buildings, furniture or property	pupil may be charged to parents by the school.

Extended childcare services	Parents are required to pay for their child's use of The Hub. The Hub is available before and after school for the additional childcare requirements of families. Parents are required to book and pay for these services in advance via ParentPay or the school office. Where the school is in receipt of pupil premium funding in respect of a child, the cost may be supported partly or fully from that funding, by prior agreement with the Head Teacher
School Meals	Parents are encouraged to book their child's meals via Parentpay. Meals are provided free of charge for children in Reception and KS1 and those in KS2 who meet the necessary criteria to qualify for Free School Meals. Children in Caterpillars Preschool or KS2, requiring a school meal will need to book and pay for their meals, in advance where possible, via Parentpay.
Late Payments	Parents are required to make payment for extended childcare services and school meals in advance. The school reserves the right to refuse to provide services or meals to those families who do not make payments on time. The school will make all efforts to recover money owed to it and reserves the right to take all necessary action to recover the debt.
