This term's topic:

Fossils

In this term's topic your child will be looking at fossils and dinosaurs. In this topic your child will explore fossils and what they tell us about history, while also looking at the life of a famous British palaeontologist and the impact of her work on the knowledge we have today.

The children will then be exploring the different time periods in which Dinosaurs inhabited the Earth while identifying the types of dinosaurs and what the possible reasons for the different time periods were.

Children will be looking at creating their own model of a fossil within Design Technology which will involve them designing and choosing the materials needed to construct it.

Homework:

By the end of year 4 pupils are expected to know all of their multiplication tables and at a competent speed of 6 seconds per question, As a result we are expecting them to practise their multiplication in both year 3 and 4 through using Timestable Rockstars daily and take part in the **garage activities and Sound Check for year 4, as they have their Multiplication check in Term 6 (WB 6th June 2022)**. There will be a weekly challenge between the three classes and the whole of KS2 so the more points your child can score the more likely their class will win a Trophy for the week.

If your child is not able to access the online activities please inform their class teacher. It is important to support your child, especially in year 4, with their multiplication tables as they are an important basis to their learning.
