This term's topic:

Rivers

Tis term will see the children exploring rivers in more depth. We will be looking at the water cycle through to the features of a river and how they are formed and to why rivers are so important to us and the environment

Multiplication Check

We only have 6 weeks until the Multiplication check where if your child is in year 4 they will be taking a test which is just as important as their KS1 or KS2 SATs or year 1 phonics screening.

This is the time where we need all parents to be working with their children on practising their multiplications and practising the speed recall. Even if your child is in year 3 now is the time to practise so they will have a head start on the practise needed to answer the 25 questions in under 6 seconds per questions.

Reading:

It is important for your child to read a minimum of 4 times a week. It really makes a huge difference in all subjects. Reading records will be collected in on a Friday to count the number of reads collected as a class to count towards the Donut Stop reading challenge. Rewards will be given to those children who have read each day. It is important that your child brings their reading books in each day as we aim to give opportunities to read independently or with an adult each day.
