This term's topic: Caesar's Journey

We are going to be reading a fantastic version of Shakespeare's play, Julius Caesar, in novel format. In geography, the children will be comparing a region in Italy to a region in the UK. We will be looking at both human and physical geographical features. The children will also learn the 8 points of a compass and use 4 and 6 figure grid references for map work as well as research Ordnance Survey symbols and keys.
