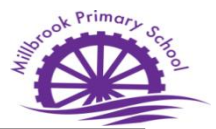

Reminders

Snacks are not provided in KS2. If you would like your child to have a morning snack they need to bring one from home - fruit, a cereal bar or another healthy choice.

Correct uniform, including black shoes, needs to be worn. Make up and jewelry are not allowed. Please remind your children to wear clothes that are appropriate for cold or wet weather.

Reading

Children should be aiming to read at home at least 5 times a week - either to an adult or independently. Children will have a book that they choose to take home.

Please support your child with their reading and record home reading in their reading record books - either you or your child can do this.

The reading record book should be brought into school each day with the child's reading book. Each Friday their total number of reads for the week will be recorded.

Please ensure that your child comes to school in the correct PE kit. Millbrook fleece or sweatshirt for outdoor PE - branded sports jumpers are not school uniform. Long hair should be tied back and earrings removed if possible.
