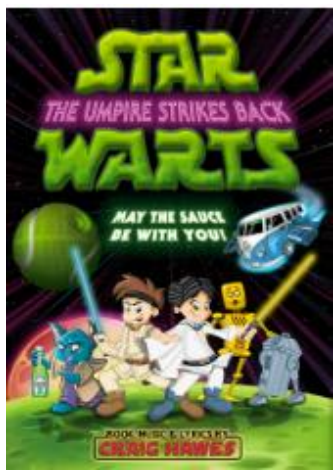
Welcome!
