Reading

We are a couple of weeks away from finishing teaching the first set of Phonemes from Floppy's Phonics. Once the children have learned all these phonemes, they will receive a word book to take home and read with you.





Phonics

We hope you're enjoying going online with your child and reading the Floppy's Phonics book each week. You can also use the blue phonics book in your child's book bag to practise saying and writing each of the phonemes. Can your child think of any words that begin with each of the phonemes? Next week, we will be putting some formation rhymes into the blue books that will help your child to remember how to write each of the letters (graphemes). Please remember that the books need to come to school each day. Thank you.

Every <u>Tuesday</u> and <u>Wednesday</u> the children need to wear their P.E. kits to school. Your child must wear the correct **P.E. kit.** This is black or white trainers, black trousers/shorts (depending on the weather) and a purple top and jumper. Thank you for your continued support.
