This term's topic:

Ancient Egyptians

In this term's topic your child will be looking at the period of the Ancient Egyptians. They will look at one of the most famous Egyptian Pharaohs as well as the geography of the land, the discovery of tombs and much more. This is an exciting topic to study and we hope the children will come home buzzing with excitement about the Egyptians too.

Homework:

This term we are working on the four operations and will be setting some maths work on Purple Mash around the methods we are using, please ensure these are completed and handed in each week by Wednesday.

All children are expected to access Times table Rockstars daily and take part in the garage activities and Sound Check for year 4. There will be a weekly challenge between the three classes and the whole of KS2 so the more points your child can score the more likely their class will win a Trophy for the week. If your child is not able to access the online activities please inform their class teacher. It is important to support your child, especially in year 4, with their multiplication tables as they are an important basis to their learning.

In order to improve vocabulary, we are focussing on 5 new words in class each week. The children will be encouraged to use them in their writing and speaking. These words will be sent to you by text each week. Please practise using them with your child to help them with their fluency.
